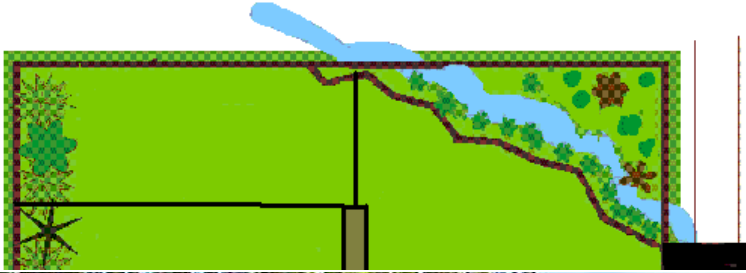

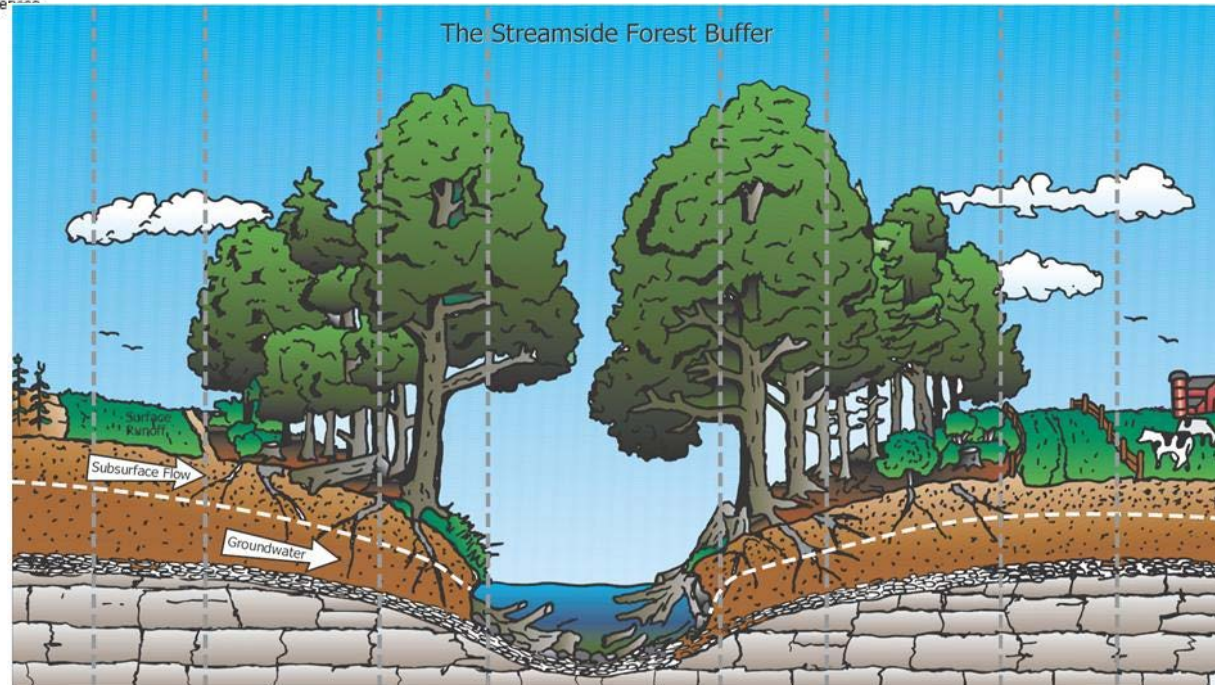


Riparian Forest Buffer

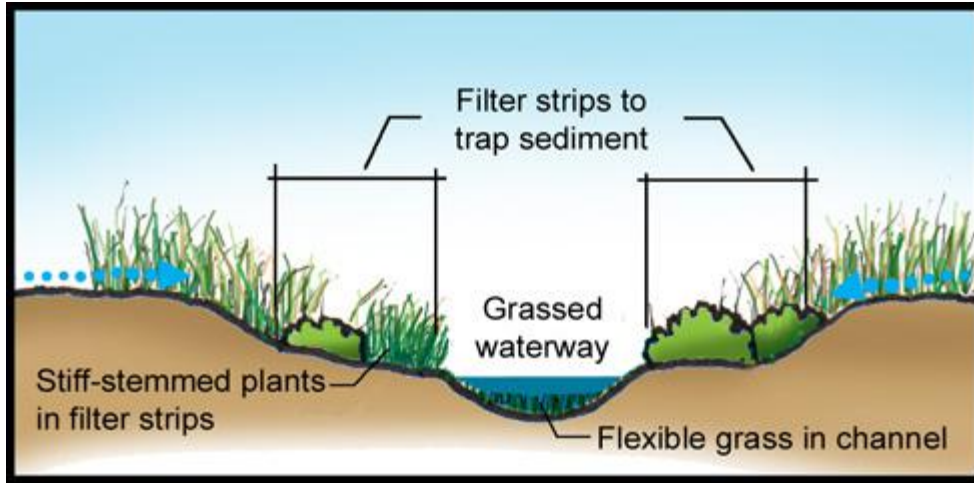

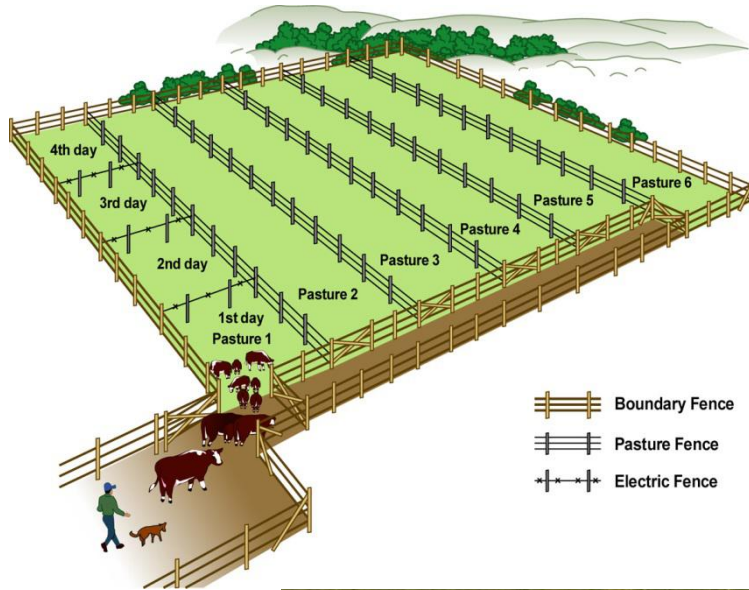
