 for how to support or refute a decision by the committee.
- Other citizen ranking criteria—Large Capital PSAR Committee Reranking considers:
 - Geographic distribution of projects
 - Reorder to more fully fund a project near funding cut-off line
 - Uncertainty of implementation
 - Project types: multiple benefit, balance of project types, balance of acquisition and restoration
